1) REGISTER A PUREBRED DOG

2) ENROLL A DOG IN AKC CANINE PARTNERS

For mixed breeds and non-AKC registrable purebreds.

Joining Canine Partners enables your dog to:

- Compete and earn titles like AKC's Canine Good Citizen and AKC Therapy Dog and get involved in exciting sports like Agility, Coursing and Tracking
- Receive benefits that include a lifetime enrollment in AKC Reunite (lost pet recovery service) and an annual subscription to Family Dog magazine

3) ENROLL A PUREBRED ALTERNATIVE LISTING (PAL)

For purebred dogs of AKC-registrable breeds not eligible for full registration

The AKC PAL is an opportunity for all purebred dogs of registrable breeds and their owners to participate in many of AKC's most popular events.

A PAL is not the equivalent of AKC registration, but makes it possible for eligible breeds to compete in events such as Obedience, Agility, Rally and more.
